

EMERGENCY WATER SHORTAGE

The City of Woodville has declared a Stage 5 - EMERGENCY Water Shortage in accordance with the City's Drought Contingency Plan. The City Water System has encountered mechanical failure at a primary water well, thereby reducing the system's water production capabilities.

To ensure that there is no major loss of water service to any customer; all NON-ESSENTIAL water use shall be prohibited.

Water system officials will issue notification lifting this restriction when water production capabilities have been restored and shall do so in the same manner as this notice.

Non-essential Water Use:

- Irrigation of landscape areas to include parks, athletic fields and golf courses
- Use of water to wash any motor vehicle, motorbike, boat, trailer, or airplane
- Use of water to wash down any sidewalk, walkway, driveway, parking lot, tennis court or other hard-surface area
- Use of water to wash down buildings or structures for purposes other than immediate fire protection
- Flushing gutters or permitting water to run or accumulate in any gutter or street
- Use of water to fill, refill or add to any swimming pool or Jacuzzi-type pool
- Use of water in a fountain or pond for aesthetic or scenic purposes except where necessary to support aquatic life
- Failure to repair a controllable leak within a reasonable period after having been given notice directing the repair of such leak
- Use of water from hydrants for construction purposes or any other purpose other than fire fighting
