### FOOD SAFETY TRAINING REQUIREMENTS CERTIFIED FOOD PROTECTION MANAGER AND FOOD HANDLER

The City of Woodville Health Department (WHD) has required food handler training for many years. The October 2015 update to the Texas Food Establishment Rules requires food handlers to complete an accredited food handler training course. The Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS) accredits food safety education and training programs for food handlers. The WHD has partnered with StateFoodSafety.com to provide DSHS and ANSI accredited training for both Certified Food Protection Managers and Food Handlers. Other training programs that are accredited by the DSHS are acceptable, however, registration with the WHD is required. The requirements are as follows:

##### Other Accredited Certified Food Protection Manager Training Course

Complete course → Bring certificate of completion copy to City Hall → Pay \$40 registration fee
